Voting/Nomination Periods	The Best Local Theatre Teacher Award Contest 2022, sponsored by SDCCU (“Award Contest”) begins on Monday May 2, 2022 3:00 p.m. Pacific Time (PT) and ends on Friday May 13, 2022 5:00 p.m. PT.
Winner Selection Date:	The one (1) Nominee with the most votes on the voting site during the Award Contest Period will be selected as the grand prize winner and notified on or around 5/16/22 and will be announced publicly at the 2022 Broadway San Diego Awards on 5/29/22. Entry in the Award Contest does not constitute entry in any other promotion, Award Contest or contest.
Eligibility:	The Award Contest is open to lawful, permanent residents of the United States, 18 years of age or older and who are not considered a minor in their state of residence, excluding Florida and New York. Employees, vendors, Board Members, volunteers and consultants of SDCCU and its subsidiaries, and their immediate family members (e.g. parents, children, siblings, spouse) and members of their households (whether related or not) are not eligible to win. Award Contest is void in Florida, New York, Puerto Rico, U.S. territories and possessions, outside of the United States, and where restricted or prohibited by law. Award Contest subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws. SDCCU reserves the right to disqualify entrants who fail to follow these Official Rules or who make any misrepresentations relative to the Award Contest or redemption of prize. Entries by ineligible persons, fraudulent entries or entries created in error will be disqualified and an alternate entry selected. Nominees, Nominators (defined below), and Voters (defined below) are collectively referred to in these Official Rules as “ Participants ” or a “ Participant. ” Previous winners are not eligible to be nominated.
How to Enter:	If you (“Nominator”) know of a deserving theatre teacher currently employed at a high school in San Diego County who has made a positive difference in your life, the life of your child or in your community (each a “Nominee”), Nominator can enter him or her in the Award Contest during the Award Contest Period as follows: (1) visit the SDCCU page (the “Site”); (2) fill out and submit the entry form including all information requested such as a narrative description (the “Submission”). Entry and voting will close at the end of the Award Contest Period. When making an entry, each Nominator; must comply with the following requirements (“Nomination Requirements”): (1) Nominator may only enter and provide information about a Nominee with the Nominee’s express permission to do so; (2) Nominator may only enter a Nominee who meets the eligibility criteria above and who is a drama or theatre teacher in San Diego County; (3) the Nominee must provide upon request all appropriate clearances, permissions and releases for the Submission (in the event an Participant cannot provide all required releases, Sponsor reserves the right, in Sponsor’s sole discretion, to disqualify the applicable Submission, or

VOTING:

Once a Nominee is entered, the Submission will be reviewed by the Sponsor. SDCCU will not verify receipt of entries for entrants. Mechanically reproduced entries will not be accepted. Once submitted, all entries become the property of SDCCU and none will be returned. SDCCU assumes no responsibility for any error, problem or malfunction (human, technical, or otherwise) which may occur in the creation, maintenance or processing of Award Contest entries, or which prevents entries from being created. Sponsor is the official timekeeper for the Award Contest. PRIZE DRAWINGS. The teacher with the most votes online will be deemed the winner of the Award Contest. Winners will be notified via phone, email or other methods using the contact information provided at entry. Entrants may only win one (1) time during all of the Award Contest. SDCCU will make its best reasonable effort to contact the winner. If any potential prize winner does not respond to prize notification attempts within two (2) days of the first notification attempt (or such shorter time as exigencies may require), is found to be ineligible, or if he or she has not complied with these Official Rules or declines the applicable prize for any reason prior to award, such potential prize winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner may be selected. Sponsor may successively attempt to contact up to two (2) potential prize winners in accordance with such procedure, and if there is still no confirmed prize winner after such attempts have been made, if any, the applicable prize may go unawarded.

ARBITRATION PROVISION: Unless you are an active duty member of the armed forces or are on active Guard or Reserve duty, or your account otherwise falls under the protections of the MLA or is otherwise exempt from arbitration under federal law, you agree that any and all claims arising from or relating to this Agreement or any service provided by SDCCU to you shall be subject to binding arbitration under the Federal Arbitration Act ("FAA"). This includes claims based on contract, tort, equity, statute, or otherwise, as well as claims regarding the scope and enforceability of this provision. It includes all claims by or against you, co-members, co-borrowers, SDCCU, and others providing or receiving any product or service related to this Agreement or your account with SDCCU. However, at the election of any party, a court of competent jurisdiction may adjudicate any request for injunctive relief, but all other claims will first be decided by arbitration under this Agreement.

A single Arbitrator shall decide all claims and shall render a final, written decision. You may choose the American Arbitration Association ("AAA"), Judicial Arbitration and Mediation Service ("JAMS"), or other similar arbitration service provider acceptable to SDCCU to administer the arbitration. Consistent with the FAA, the appropriate AAA rules, JAMS rules, or other service provider rules shall apply, as determined by the Arbitrator. For AAA and JAMS, these rules are found at www.adr.org and www.jamsadr.com.

Unless otherwise agreed by the parties, the arbitration shall take place in San Diego, California.

Each party to the arbitration shall pay his, her, or its own costs of arbitration. If you cannot afford your arbitration costs, you may apply for a waiver under the relevant rules.

The parties waive any right to bring representative claims on behalf of a class of individuals (the "class action waiver").

The arbitration provision may be severed or modified if necessary to render it enforceable
